The permit shall expire for work completed (including pavement restoration) within 15 days after issuance of a permit, and a new permit shall be required before completing the work.

Under no circumstances shall the permittee or his agent commence the backfilling of an excavation without the approval of the Director of Public Works or his designee for the purpose of ascertaining whether the backfill material is proper and adequately compacted. Final arrangements for such monitoring must be made by notifying the Colchester Public Works Department at (802) 264-5620.

In the event the Select Board determines certain repairs or modifications to a town highway are required for public safety and convenience, utilities will be expected to cooperate in relocating their facilities as reasonably requested by the Town. The granting of a permit or the monitoring of operations conducted under any permit shall not make the town of Colchester, any of its representatives responsible for construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, procedures or permittee's failure to perform the work in accordance with the standards and specifications set forth in the Manual for Uniform Traffic control Devices, nor shall any approval granted by any Town Official under Chapter 13 make any such official responsible for any personal injury or property damage as a result of the permittee operations.

The acceptance of any permit required by Chapter 13 (adopted 1992) shall bind the applicant and his agents to the terms and conditions of such permit as well as the standards, procedures and obligations as set forth in Chapter 13, Colchester Code of Ordinances.
