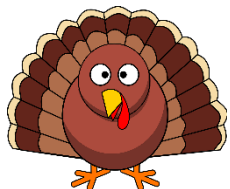

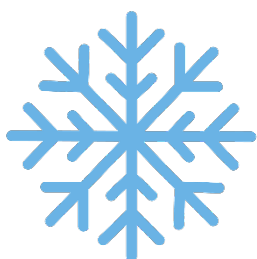
### Small Business Saturday
